

STATEWIDE EDUCATION FACT SHEET

- The Florida Lottery was created by a constitutional amendment in 1986 for the purpose of generating additional money for public education in the state of Florida.
- More than \$48.42 billion has been transferred to the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund (EETF) since the sale of the Lottery's first ticket in 1988—including over \$2.3 billion in FY 2023-24.
- For the **22nd** consecutive fiscal year, the Florida Lottery has transferred more than **\$1 billion** to the EETF.
- Florida's public schools (Pre-K and K-12 programs and school construction) have received over \$17 billion since the Lottery's inception – including more than \$234 million in FY 2023-24.
- The Florida Lottery contributed more than \$9.2 billion to the Bright Futures Scholarship Program

 including over \$606 million in FY 2023-24 allowing over one million students to attend college.
- Florida's public colleges and universities have also benefited, receiving more than **\$12 billion** since the Lottery's inception including over **\$818 million** in FY 2023-24.
