BACKGROUND:

April 29, 1988 FLORIDA LOTTO® was introduced. The first drawing, with an

estimated \$2 million jackpot, occurred on May 7, 1988, and

resulted in a rollover.

February 6, 1993 The FLORIDA LOTTO® prize structure changed to provide higher

prize payouts for LOTTO players.

November 15, 1998 FLORIDA LOTTO® jackpot payouts change from a 20-year annual

payment option to a choice between a 30-year Annual Payment

Option and a one-time, lump-sum payment Cash Option.

October 24, 1999 Wednesday drawings were added to the FLORIDA LOTTO[®]

schedule. The matrix changed from 46 to 53 numbers, and players

who match three, four, or five of six numbers now receive

substantially larger prizes.

March 2, 2008 The Florida Lottery began offering \$2 and \$3 play LOTTO PLUS™,

which allows players to add millions more to their jackpot.

October 11, 2009 FLORIDA LOTTO® with XTRA™ was introduced, replacing LOTTO

PLUS[™]. The \$1 add-on feature offers players the opportunity to

win extra on non-jackpot prizes.

September 9, 2013 JACKPOT COMBO was introduced, offering players the

convenience of playing all three big jackpot games in a single

	transaction. For \$5, players receive one \$2 POWERBALL®, one \$2 FLORIDA LOTTO® with XTRA, and one \$1 MEGA MILLIONS® Quick Pick ticket for the next available draw date.
October 28, 2017	JACKPOT COMBO was increased to \$6; players receive one \$2 POWERBALL®, one \$2 FLORIDA LOTTO® with XTRA, and one \$2 MEGA MILLIONS® Quick Pick ticket for the next available draw date.
January 1, 2018	EZmatch $^{\rm m}$ is added to FLORIDA LOTTO $^{\rm s}$, allowing players to win up to \$500 instantly by matching any of the EZmatch numbers with any of the FLORIDA LOTTO numbers on their ticket.
April 11, 2020	The starting jackpot is lowered to \$1 million.
October 8, 2020	FLORIDA LOTTO® was enhanced to give players bigger prizes and better odds. FLORIDA LOTTO tickets increased to \$2 per play, and a \$1 add-on feature called Double Play™ was introduced.

The millionaire's count includes unclaimed and expired tickets. Includes FLORIDA LOTTO with EZmatch and FLORIDA LOTTO with Double Play.
